

Which Phoenix hike are we conquering?

Dreamy Draw Nature Trail is a 1.5-mile intermediate loop with an elevation gain of approximately 380 feet, nestled in the midst of mountains away from the city. There is also a route that is less strenuous for those who enjoy a more leisurely hike and a more rigorous trail for those who are more adventurous.



Driving To The Trail

Exit Northern Avenue off SR 51 North to get to Dreamy Draw. Turn right onto Northern Avenue at stop light after exiting. Follow the long road (if the lot is filled, you can park along this road) all the way to the paved parking lot to meet all the other excited hikers!

Become A Participant In FOUR Easy Steps

- ❶ Complete attached form and mail to:
St. Joseph the Worker Job Service
P.O. Box 13503 – Phoenix, Arizona 85002-3503.
Include registration fee (see step number 2) with form.
- ❷ Participants are welcome to hike individually or as a group. There is a registration fee for all hikers. It is:
 - Individual: \$10 (Pre-registration)
\$15 (Day-of-hike registration)
 - Group: \$7 for each individual in the group (five or more individuals make a group; this can be paid as a lump)
- ❸ Raise additional money for SJW up until the day of the hike. Ask everyone you know (neighbors, relatives, co-workers, etc.) to sponsor you in the hike! The more people you ask, the better our services become! Keep track of your individual sponsors (additional sheets available). Collect the money and turn it in with pledge forms on the morning of the hike. Prizes will be awarded to the child, adult, and group who raise the most amount of money.
- ❹ Show up Saturday morning, **March 12**, as early as 8 a.m. to check in and receive a raffle ticket plus a St. Joseph the Worker event tee shirt for participating. At **9 a.m.**, be ready to hike, socialize, and learn all about SJW! Grand prizes will be announced at the start of the hike. Other prizes will be distributed throughout the morning on the trail.
