## Partnership in Service

**Assisting homeless, low-income and other disadvantaged individuals in their efforts to become self-sufficient through quality employment.**

St. Joseph the Worker (SJW) is a small, local, privately funded organization making a direct impact on our community.

During fiscal year 2011/2012, SJW and our clients achieved the following successes:

- 433 homeless and low-income individuals secured 577 job placements
- \$9.20 an hour was the average starting pay rate for these individuals.
- 63% of the jobs secured offered benefits.
- 610 individuals received comprehensive assistance, including one-on-one job search assistance, job-readiness resources and referrals, as well as encouragement and support to pursue a self-sufficient lifestyle.
- 433 incarcerated individuals were taught job-search strategies and job-readiness to help them avoid homelessness or re-incarceration after their release.
- 1,743 hours of direct volunteer service to help our hardworking clients in their search for quality employment.
